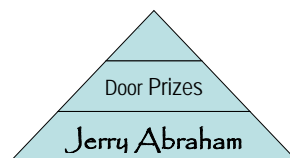

All Artwork must be turned in by 3PM May 4. Artwork brought in after Friday will not be accepted. An Artwork Registration Form must be attached to each piece. Forms are available at The Path, the Clinics and Peer Centers, and by e-mail request to JLQMD@att.net with subject line "Art Show Registration Form". Forms will be available at the Taj on May 4. Please have all artwork taken from the Taj Mahal immediately after the Art Show ends on May 8. **Artwork may be sold/purchased at the Show with direct payment to the Artist.**

Authors Writing entries may be submitted by e-mail beginning Monday April 16 with the **DEADLINE for submissions at midnight Thursday April 26, 2018.** All writing **MUST be submitted by email** and does NOT need a registration form. All submissions will receive a return e-mail within 24-48 hours. If you do not receive a response please check the e-mail address and make sure your subject line says "Creative Writing Contest". Each writing entry must include the following information: 1) a title, 2) your first and last name and contact information, 3) Your Representatives name if you are not attending. *Art or Writing with violent themes will not be displayed.*
